**A**fter graduation, Sworn Translators apply to the Colegio de Traductores Públicos de la Ciudad de Buenos Aires (Association of Sworn Translators of the city of Buenos Aires) for a license, which enables them to do official translations. An official translation is a translation signed and sealed by a Sworn Translator, and has the same legal force and effect as the original document.

Whenever a foreign document has to be filed with a governmental agency in Argentina, it is necessary to have it translated into Spanish by a Sworn Translator.
